DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GREENSEAL™ is for application to pruning wounds made during the dormant period.

GREENSEAL™ is not for application to crops bearing fruit.

- Shake or stir GREENSEAL™ well before use.
- Never thin GREENSEAL™ with water, as the product will not provide adequate coverage.
- Apply GREENSEAL™ thickly to dry wound surface with a paint brush or applicator brush on the same day as the pruning cut is made.
- Do not apply GREENSEAL™ to wounds showing excessive brown staining.
- Apply GREENSEAL™ on fine, sunny or windy days - but avoid applying on wet, foggy days as the product may not dry for some time.
- Large wounds (>50mm diameter) on a main trunk would benefit from a second application of GREENSEAL™.
- Brushes and applicators should be washed out in water after use of GREENSEAL™.
- Reseal container after use to prevent drying out of the formulation of GREENSEAL™.

Storage: Store in original container, tightly closed, away from foodstuffs.

Shelf life: When stored appropriately, this product should show no significant degradation for two years from the date of manufacture. Contact your supplier for further information about the use of any product that is older than this.
